TASTING NOTE

This cabernet franc rosé from our home block in Blewitt Springs is a light salmon pink. It has a lifted bouquet of lemon blossom and Turkish delight, with hints of strawberry and lavender. The palate is refreshing and dry, with crisp natural acidity pleasantly balanced by light flavours of strawberry, raspberry and a touch of blueberry. Vibrant and mouthwatering, this rosé will leave you wanting more.

WINEMAKING

The 2021 vintage in McLaren Vale is being heralded by the local wine community as one of the best harvests of recent times. The region experienced the wettest spring in 10 years, followed by a cool dry summer, ensuring a very good growing stage early on. As the season progressed into the ripening stage of the fruit, the onus was on growers to irrigate if and when necessary to keep both the vines and fruit happy and healthy. Friends and family carefully handpicked this cabernet franc rosé early in the ripening season to capture the more delicate spectrum of flavours from the fruit. The fruit went straight into a delicate press cycle to extract only the lightest and most delicate flavours, thus avoiding the pickup of any anthocyanins and other astringent, phenolic compounds. A long and cool fermentation resulted in a lovely refreshing and delicate rosé.
